

Group Spies

A variation on group work with the aim of considering alternative viewpoints and interpretations.

How it works

Half-way through a group task ask students to select a 'spy' who will visit another table and listen to the discussion that is taking place. They then go back to their home group and divulge any secrets they have gleaned from the group they spied on. The group will then consider the new information and use it to help them in the task.
