4x4 Post it Notes

Great for revision

How it works

-In groups pupils are given 16 post-it notes and asked to arrange into a 4x4 grid on the table in front of them (or even the window or walls). The table can act as the grid so no need to create any kind of resource!

-Pupils then use text books, prior knowledge and exercise books to help them add one topic related key word to each post-it note.

-Pupils then either add definitions to their own key words or swap with another group and add definitions to their key words.

-Pupils are then asked to rearrange their own grid so that post-it notes beside each other link.

-Pupils are then asked to rearrange their grid so that the post it either side and above all link.

-Finally key word-links can then be used to complete an exam question or piece of writing.
