Turn the fact into a question for a quiz

This is a good starter or plenary activity with a topic that's being explored over several lessons as you can have several quiz questions at a time; otherwise, a whole lesson can be taken up with it!

How it works

Example:

Students are asked to find a fact about colour for their homework. The fact that one YR8 boy came in with was about football and it was that some changing rooms for the away team are painted in pink.

On returning with their fact the starter for the lesson is to change it into a question. Therefore this would become "In football what colour is the away teams changing room painted, and why?

The pupil asks their question to the class, and chooses who answers, if the pupil gets it right they can have a credit; if they get it wrong they themselves have the credit. They can also gain further rewards if you as the teacher can't answer the question!
