



Dear Parents/Carers,

## Subject: Year 10 Progress Report

Your son/daughter has now been issued with their latest Progress Report. Included in this report are:

- **Subjects taken at Key Stage 4**
- **Current grade (based on teacher assessment of progress to date)**
- **The student's target grade for the end of Year 11 in each subject**
- **Attendance figures for the year to date**
- **Where applicable, the trial exam result for the Religious Studies Short Course**

The current grade is a holistic judgement of the student's current capabilities in each subject, based on a range of assessments and work done in class. It should reflect the grade the student is currently working at. It is not a projected or predicted grade. The current grade may be slightly lower than the Year 11 target grade, as the students are still developing the knowledge and acquiring the skills necessary to reach and exceed this grade in their final exams.

To be on track to meet the student's target grade in Year 11, we would expect them to be achieving **one to two grades below that target at this stage of Year 10.**

Using the lettered grading system:

- 6A - student is working at a high grade 6 and with effort could move up to a grade 7.
- 6B - student is working at a secure grade 6.
- 6C - student is working at a low grade 6 and is in danger of dropping to a grade 5.

In addition, there are three colour coded columns:

- **On Track?** This shows if your son or daughter is on track to achieve their target grade.
- **Attitude to Learning.** This shows the attitude to learning that they bring to their lessons.
- **Lesson Readiness.** This shows how organised students are and how prepared they are for their lessons by completing work outside of the school day.

On the back of the Progress Report are a few explanatory notes and a table showing the importance of good attendance for your child's learning.

Please note that any subject specific queries and questions need to go directly to your child's subject teacher or tutorial teacher. You can contact any teacher by clicking on the 'Email a member of staff' link on the Vyners website.

Please look at this information with your child and use it to help them focus on areas for development in order to meet or exceed their target grade. We value your support and hope that this information will allow you to engage in conversations with your child about their progress.


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
