Subject Y13 Freud Museum trip – 22 January 2024

Students will be exploring the museum of Freud and looking at aspects of the Psychodynamic approach, learned as part of the A Level Specification. Students will also be attending a talk on the curious case of Little Hans, also within a topic students have studied on their A Level course.

Our visit starts at 10am at the Freud Museum (20 Maresfield Gardens, London, NW3 5SX). Students will need to be at **Hillingdon Station at 8:45am** to be registered before getting the Metropolitan line to Finchley Road.

The event will finish at approximately **1pm**. Students will have the option to either accompany staff back to Hillingdon Station, or, they can stay in London. If you are happy for your child to remain in London, please give this authority by completing the question on sQuid.

Students are to **bring their own food/ money to buy food**. They will have the opportunity to have lunch independently after our visit.

Students can wear their **own clothes**, these must be appropriate and students are to **bring their school lanyard** as they are representing Vyners School.

The cost of the trip will be £11.50, payment should be made via sQuid, our online payment system. Cash and cheques will not be accepted. Please log onto the system (www.squidcard.com) and select the 'trips/activities purse'. This trip will be clearly visible as Psychology Freud Museum Yr 23/24 and must be specifically selected in order to make payment. Please follow the instructions on screen. An emailed receipt will automatically be sent to you by the system once payment is made.

It is very important that payment is made before the stated deadline of 30 November 2023. The school does not have funds available to meet the cost of late contributions. Regretfully, a failure to pay promptly may result in your son or daughter being removed from the trip.
