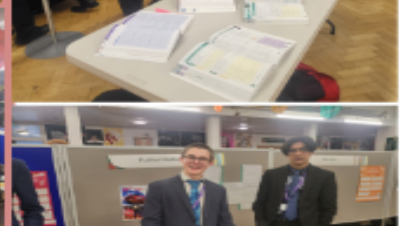
VYNERS CAREERS BULLETIN

Year 12 student led assembly

A group of Year 12 students led yesterday's assembly, challenging the rest of the Sixth Form to decide which book has most changed our world over the last thousand years. Students delivered 80-second presentations on their choice of book, outlining why their book has had the most impact. The students put forward cases for Issac Newton's *Principia Mathematica*; Michael Faraday's *Experimental Researches in Electricity*; William Wilberforce's *On the Abolition of the Slave Trade*; Marie Stope's *Married Love*; Shakespeare's *First Folio*; Charles Darwin's *On the Origin of Species*; *The Magna Carta*; *The Rule Book of Association Football*; Mary Wollstonecraft's *A Vindication of the Rights of Women* and Richard Arkwright's *Patent Specifications for Arkwright's Spinning Machine*. Year 12 and 13 students have all been casting their votes on which argument they found most convincing.
