Dear Parent / Carer

Re: Tuesday 1st July–Transition Day (9am- 2pm)

Congratulations on securing a place for your child at Vyners School. We are really looking forward to welcoming your child here on **Tuesday 1st July 2025** and yourselves in the evening.

Transition Day is a critical first step in the transition to secondary school for your child. Students will meet their new classmates and (in many cases) their tutor, as well as taking part in various planned activities including tours, assemblies and some taster lessons in English, PE, Art, or Science. Please arrange for your child to be brought to the Vyners Quad (playground) **by 9.00am, but not before 8.50am**, as it is important that we get all our older students into lessons first. Staff will be at the main gates (vehicle entrance) to direct you onto the Quad. Please walk if at all possible as parents will not be allowed to bring cars on to the school site and Warren Road becomes very easily congested. We ask that children proudly wear their present primary school uniform, looking smart and ready to learn.

Children should bring their own packed lunch including a drink. The school encourages students to bring reusable water bottles to be able to refill these during the day if needed. You may also wish to supply a snack for morning break. If your child requires any access to medication in school, please ensure this is handed to a member of staff and is clearly labelled with the correct information and directions for use. It is essential that children bring equipment on the day, i.e. a full pencil case including a pen, a pencil and a rubber. A pair of trainers would be useful to change into for any sport activity.

At the end of the day we ask that children are collected from the Quad at **2.00pm**. Any medications will be available for collection from the main reception at this time. If children are allowed to make their own way home, please indicate this via this [Google Form](#).

We encourage reading for pleasure at the school and, in order to instil this, we would like every new Year 7 to read 'The Daydreamer' by Ian McEwan over the summer before joining Vyners in September. This book will be loaned to students on Transition Day. All we ask is that you take time to make sure that they read it and then speak to them about their experiences. They will also need to write a book report. You may wish to read the book as well to enable you and your child to have an informed conversation about it. The students will spend some time in September in their English classes discussing their book reports and will be asked to return the book to their English teacher in their first English lesson in September.
