

Dear Year 11 students, Parents and Carers,

Subject: Final Prom Information

I hope this email finds you well. The purpose of this email is to outline some key information regarding Prom, as well as to remind you all of the expectations that you consented to upon purchasing a ticket. Please can you have a conversation with your child before the event in question about the following:

Date: Thursday 20th June, 2024

Timings: Arrival from 18.30. Official Start Time: 19.00. End Time: 23.00.

Venue: The Pinewood Hotel, Wexham Park Lane, George Green, Slough, SL3 6AP

Dress Code: Smart - Ballroom

Cost: The ticket price consists of: venue hire, a buffet meal, one non-alcoholic cocktail upon entry, security and supervision, DJ, decorations, firework display, and a magic-mirror photo booth. The price of the ticket does not include transportation to and from the venue. Please ensure that you are able to drop off and pick up your child at the timings above.

Other Costings: Your child can purchase their own drinks on the night, prices range from £3.00 - £3.50. They take cash and card.

Other Timings: The buffet will be open upstairs from 20.00. The Photobooth will be available until 21.30. Fireworks will start at 22.00.

Expectations:

1. No smoking, vaping or drinking (including before arrival - anyone suspected of drinking alcohol; will not be permitted). If anyone is seen smoking, vaping, or drinking, the students involved will be immediately sent home.
2. If the venue is left at any time during the evening, there will be no re-admittance.
3. If there is any cause for concern regarding behaviour, the students involved will be immediately sent home.

If you cannot come and pick up your child if any of these expectations are not met, Parents will be expected to meet the cost of any transportation.

This is an occasion to celebrate together as a year group, and as this is an event run by the school, there will be security on the door to search bags and pockets as guests enter. If any student is deemed to be under the influence of any substance or is carrying any contraband, we reserve the right to refuse entry.

Allergies / Dietary requirements: All food in the buffet is labelled, with a variety of options. Please ensure that your child brings any medication / epipens / inhalers that they may need for the event.

Entry: Only Vyners students who have purchased a ticket will be allowed entry. There will be strictly no other entry for plus ones, or guests.

After the sheer amount of hard work, dedication and effort you have put into your education, Prom is a great opportunity to celebrate this success. It is a valued tradition at Vyners, which has formed an important part of our end of year celebrations with both students and staff.
