Year 12 and 13 Exams - Summary of Information

Year 13 exams start Monday 11th May for 5 weeks

Year 12 exams start Monday 1st June for 2 weeks

AM exams

EXAM START: 9:00am

Year 13 register in the Study Room at 8:30am as you need to be seated in the Sports Hall by 8:50am.

Year 12 register in 116.

Entry to school is at the usual time between 7.45am - 8.30am.

PM exams

EXAM START: 13:00

Register in the Study Room at 12:30 as you will need to be seated in the Sports Hall by 12:50.

Year 12 register in 116.

Entry to school for the PM exam is between 12:15 and 12:30.

BAG DROP

Bags will be left in the Study Room prior to half term.

After half term bags will be left in Room 116.

LATENESS or ILLNESS

You must report to reception. If you are late for a genuine reason, call the Study Room as soon as you can on 01895 234342 and enter ext 4244.

In case of an emergency and you cannot attend an exam, you need to call the Sixth Form ASAP on the number above. We can then advise you on how to proceed with attending your exam on this day. It is advisable that you sit the exam on this day and try to get a doctor's note ASAP.

EQUIPMENT

Get prepared and sort yourself out with a clear exam pencil case including all of the equipment you need.

If you think you will forget this, we will keep it locked away in the Study Room for you.

Remember - you write in **BLACK INK ONLY**.

Water bottles must have the label removed.

No equipment will be provided inside the venue (except if your pen breaks).

STANDARDS

- Lanyards are compulsory - you will need them as ID for the exam venue. You might not be able to enter the exam if you have no lanyard.
- Smart professional uniform only.
A metal detector will be used to double check that you have no mobile phone, airpods, watches etc. Expect to be asked to show ears, wrists etc while being registered.

SILENT STUDY

Year 13 are welcome to come into school for silent study during exams.

During Year 12 exams, silent study will move to Room 116 for 2 weeks.

Uniform reminders - Summer Term

A reminder that uniforms **MUST** remain smart as we move into the warmer months of school. The saying "always wear a collar" still applies. If wearing a t-shirt or blouse without a collar, then a blazer will need to be worn.

Please ensure the following:

- Necklines of blouses are appropriate for school wear - **no low cut tops**.
- **No bare shoulders** - you will be asked to wear a blazer if shoulders are on show
- **No skorts**.
- Skirts will need to be of a decent length especially if not wearing tights (think below mid thigh). If we deem a skirt to be too short, then we will ask you to go home and change.

- **Practical shorts must also be of a suitable length and suitable style** - absolutely no skin tight shorts.

UCAS Parent Information Evening

On **Monday 22nd June 2026** we will be holding an Information Evening for parents about Post 18 choices available to students. There will be information to support applications to University and Apprenticeships. We will also give information to support students in the transition from Year 12 to Year 13. The evening will begin at 18:00.

Summer Assessments - Monday 1st June to Friday 12th June 2026

Year 12 End of Year assessments will take place between the dates of **Monday 1st June and Friday 12th June 2026**.

Students have already received their summer assessment schedule here, which is available on Google Classroom. This document also includes topic lists for each subject.

Year 12 Study Leave

During the period that Year 12 students take part in their end of year assessments, they will be granted study leave. This means that during the weeks commencing the **1st and 8th of June**, Year 12 students will only need to come into school when they have an exam. For students studying coursework based subjects, attendance in school will be at the discretion of the teacher. This will depend on the progress of their coursework and if they are behind on any work.

On the days when students have an exam, they need to register in the study room at 8:30am for a morning exam and 12:30 for an afternoon exam. All students will receive an exams assembly on **Thursday 21st May** which will inform them of the processes and expectations of them during this period.

If you require a call back you can do this by completing the Google Form in the results email. A member of the Sixth Form team will call back between 09:30am and 11:00am. A link to the marking review and resit documentation will also be in the results email.

Do not call the school or email individual teachers as we will only be working off the Google Form information on that morning.

School will be open between 11:00am and 12:00pm for students to collect a paper copy of their results. We would be delighted to see the students and to celebrate their achievements together.

Vyners School computer accounts
