Exam Season - Well done and Welcome Back

With only one week left for Year 13 A level exams we would like to say a massive well done to those Year 12 and 13 students who have so diligently sat exams over the last few weeks. We are so proud of your professionalism and positive attitude throughout this exam season. We wish Year 13 every success (and a very well deserved break) following their final exam next Thursday.

We welcome Year 12 back to school on **Monday 15th June 2026** well rested and recuperated following Summer Exams. The next few weeks are a chance to reflect on Year 12 and to make plans on how to bridge any gaps in learning ahead of Year 13 with the support of class teachers and the Sixth Form team.

Uniform reminders - Summer Term

A reminder that uniforms **MUST** remain smart as we move into the warmer months of school. The saying "always wear a collar" still applies. If wearing a t-shirt or blouse without a collar, then a blazer will need to be worn.

Please ensure the following:

- Necklines of blouses are appropriate for school wear - **no low cut tops.**
- **No bare shoulders** - you will be asked to wear a blazer if shoulders are on show
- **No skorts.**
- Skirts will need to be of a decent length especially if not wearing tights (think below mid thigh). If we deem a skirt to be too short, then we will ask you to go home and change.
- The rules for practical kit remain the same - please ensure that t-shirts are black or white

- **Practical shorts must also be of a suitable length and suitable style** - absolutely no skin tight shorts.

You must look and present professionally at all times. We will start to send students home if we deem your uniform unsuitable for school.

We also have a range of school uniforms for students to "borrow" should they be unable to go home and change.

UCAS and Next Steps Days 2025

On **Tuesday 23rd June** we will hold a drop down day for our annual UCAS Conference. Students will receive information on applying to University, apprenticeships and employment through a series of presentations and practical workshops. This will include all Year 12 students registering for UCAS. Students will be required to be in school on this day until **15:00**, but may be able to leave earlier if they have completed all of their tasks.

On day 2 (**Wednesday 24th June** 12C, 12F, 12G, 12H and **Thursday 25th June** 12J, 12M, 12P, 12W) students will collate all of their super and extra curricular experiences from Year 12 and will start to write

their personal statement. Students will be dismissed on this day at **12:30** with optional 1 to 1 meetings taking place during P4&5 with a member of the Sixth Form team, should a student require extra guidance.

UCAS Parent Information Evening

On **Tuesday 23rd June 2026** we will be holding an information evening for parents about Post 18 choices available to students. There will be information delivered to support applications to university and apprenticeships. We will also give information to support students in the transition from Year 12 to Year 13. The evening will begin at **18:00** in room **006/007**. Please enter through the main school reception, where a member of the Sixth Form team will be on hand to greet you.

Sports Day

Sports day will take place across two days and all Year 12 students will be involved on one day. It is important that students arrive at Hillingdon Athletics track at **8:45am** to be registered by the Sixth Form Team. On the day students are not at Sports Day they will be attending school to take part in Year 12 UCAS day.

Year 12 students will receive their progress reports, which will contain the results of their end of year assessments, on **Wednesday 8th July**. Alumni Tutoring

A number of students and parents will be starting to receive emails regarding our Alumni Tuition programme. Initially, we will be offering tuition to students who have been identified by their teachers as needing some extra support. If declined, we then start to offer out to all other students. All of our tutors are Vyners alumni from the past 5 years who achieved an A or A* in their subject and have been verified and recommended by Vyners staff. We offer 2-1 and 1-1 sessions. The Sixth Form team and subject staff will be in school from 11:00 am to 12:00 pm. We invite students into school to collect a paper copy of their results and celebrate their fantastic achievements together.

Mitigating circumstances

Many universities accept mitigating circumstances forms if a student's learning or exam preparation was impacted by factors that arose after they submitted their UCAS application. If a student feels this applies to them, it is highly recommended that they speak to a member of the Sixth Form Team as soon as possible. We can offer guidance on the process and ensure we are prepared, as universities will contact the school to verify these details.

Apprenticeship/ jobs/ change of plans

Could we please ask any students who have secured an apprenticeship, a job, or had a change of plans to email us with their confirmed details? Having this information ensures we can maintain an accurate and complete record of our students' destinations.

Vyners School computer accounts

Year 13 students will only be able to use their Vyners computer accounts until **Friday 30th October 2026**. On this date the accounts and all data including emails will be deleted. There will be no exceptions to this rule unless students are doing retakes and still require access, but they must inform us of this prior to 30th October as **once data is deleted it will not be retrievable by IT Support**.

Please note that any files that students own that they have shared with others will also be deleted.

Students can opt to transfer their Google Data out using Google Takeout. This requires them to have a personal Google Account.

It is the students responsibility to ensure they have enough space on their own personal account to transfer any school data.
