Dear Parents and Carers,

We have been informed that there are discussions across local schools of the potential of a large gathering this afternoon/evening on the fields close to the Hillingdon Athletics Track.

We have also received information suggesting that this may lead to anti-social behaviour. At this time, we are unable to verify the accuracy of these reports and cannot confirm whether this information is factual or simply rumour. We have been in contact with the local Police to share our concerns and ask for guidance. We have been informed that there will be an increased Police presence in this area this evening.

We have taken the decision to contact parents to ensure that appropriate and proportionate steps can be taken to keep children and our community safe.

We would encourage all parents and carers to:

- be aware of their child's whereabouts and encourage them to avoid this area
- discuss personal safety and responsible decision-making with their child
- remind their child to leave any situation immediately and seek help if they feel unsafe or become aware of any threatening or dangerous behaviour
- contact the police if they become aware of any immediate risk to the safety of young people

While we hope these reports are unfounded, we believe it is important to share information that may assist families in keeping children safe.
